



## Cell Phones and Texting

Students may bring cell phones to school for use **before school begins, during lunch, and after school.** Cell phones must be off during class periods and during passing. Texting is not allowed except before school, during lunch and after school.

Students using their cell phones and/or texting during unauthorized times will have their phone taken away.

**1<sup>st</sup> Offense:** Student may retrieve the phone after school hours.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Offense:** Parent must retrieve the phone.

**3<sup>rd</sup> Offense:** Parent must retrieve the phone and student cell phone privileges are suspended for the remainder of the semester.

## Electronic Signaling Devices

Ed. Code Section 48901.5 prohibits the possession or use of any electronic signaling device on school grounds without the prior consent of the principal. **Students may possess cell phones on campus but they are to be turned off and put away except before and after school and at lunch.** Cell phones which are used during the school day, including during passing periods, will be confiscated. Repeat offenses will be treated as a defiance of authority.
