Dear Parents & Students:

On Thursday afternoon, **AUGUST 13TH, 2009** all freshmen and new students will have their orientation to Yosemite High School. The orientation process will start when the Yosemite High School busses pick up your son/daughter at their normal bus location for the 2009-10 school year. We are enclosing a list of school bus pickup locations and times for each bus route. Your son/daughter should be at the bus stop 10 minutes prior to the listed pickup time. Students will make their regular bus run to the Yosemite High School campus, arriving for a student orientation beginning at 3:00 p.m.

The "New Student Orientation" will begin with a BADGER assembly, where students will be divided into groups with student leaders. The groups will participate in a number of activities including a tour of our campus.

At 6:15 p.m., we would like to invite students and parents to enjoy a barbecue sponsored by the Associated Student Body (ASB) in the cafeteria, followed by a general orientation meeting for students and parents at approximately 7:00 p.m. This orientation will feature a tour of the school and will also have individualized information sites. We encourage all parents/guardians to come to this orientation so they will be able to gain information about their student's new school as well as to transport their son/daughter home. We will have no busses transporting students back to their homes on this evening.

Our Student Store will be one of the sites on our tour where students can obtain Student Body Cards and other important items for new students on the Yosemite High School campus. Another site will feature all of the clubs and activities that your son/daughter can join, along with students and sponsors available for information.

The orientation process is a very important part of the beginning of the 2009-10 school year for your son/daughter. Please make every effort to have your student available for the afternoon session, and it is also extremely important that you, as a parent/guardian, attend the evening session. **Remember**, the Yosemite Unified School District will transport your son/daughter to the school, but it is your responsibility to transport them home after the student/adult evening orientation.
